We make every effort to ensure that patients/visitors who need to visit the hospitals regularly are helped by having the following in place:

Patient Parking is provided free of charge for:

Disabled Badge Holders	A valid disabled badge must be displayed in the vehicle. If all disabled parking bays are full, you may park in any car parking space located at either Hathersage Road or Grafton Street multi storey car parking facilities free of charge (please note width of parking bay will be standard).
	Please note this <u>excludes any of the '30 mins</u> <u>Drop-Off spaces</u> ' located along the hospital(s) frontage on the Boulevard.
