## **IgG Anti-Tissue Transglutaminase**

## **General information**

Acts as a screening test for coeliac disease/dermatitis herpetiformis

**Specimen transport:** At room temperature

Repeat frequency: Only to monitor compliance with gluten free diet in IgA deficient patients

Special precautions: None

## **Laboratory information**

Normal reference range: 0-14.9 kU/L Volume and sample type: 7ml clotted blood

Method: Multiplex flow immunoassay

Turnaround time (calendar days from sample receipt to authorised result): Median - 2

## **Clinical information**

Indications for the test: Suspected gluten sensitivity. This test is specific for coeliac disease, but a jejunal

biopsy is recommended for confirmation.

Factors affecting the test: Becomes negative on gluten free diet
