


Coronavirus (COVID-19) Patient Information

Coronaviruses often cause symptoms like those of the common cold, you may feel hot, (have a temperature/fever) a cough, sore throat or runny nose.





Some of the doctors and nurses looking after you may have to wear funny clothes. They are still smiling at you from behind their masks! They might need you and your


parent/carer to wear masks too – especially when you're moving through the hospital.

Some children will need to be tested to see whether they have the virus. This will involve swabbing the inside of your nose and mouth. It's quite quick and shouldn't hurt although it may feel a bit uncomfortable. If you stay in hospital you might need to have another swab but your nurse will let you know.
