


Do you use PubMed, Google Scholar, or other websites to look for journal articles?

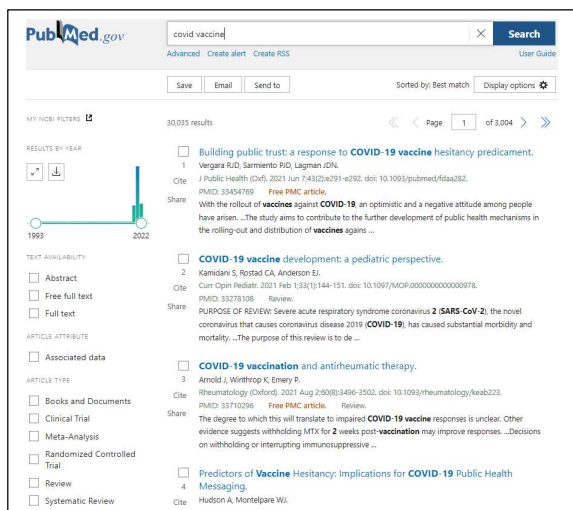
If so, you can now instantly access full-text articles of all content provided by MFT Trust Library Services plus other national and freely available content.

Please follow the instructions below to install an extension to your chosen internet browser on any computer you use:

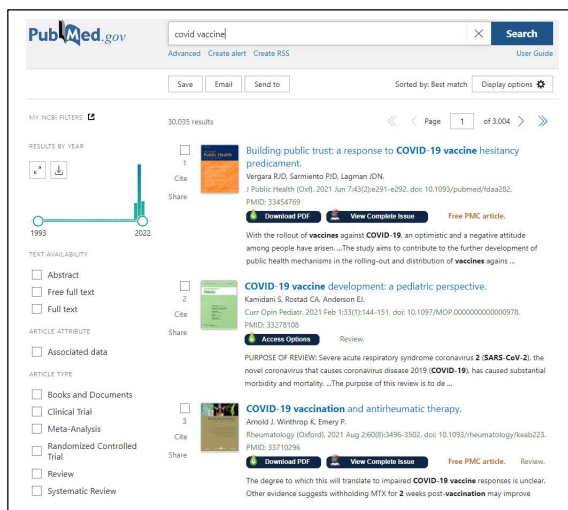
- Go to <https://thirdiron.com/downloadnomad/>
- Click on 
- Choose your browser (e.g. Chrome, Edge, Firefox)
- Click the buttons to Add/Get for your browser
- Select Manchester University NHS Foundation Trust as your organisation

The browser extension will now result in clearly displayed **journal images** and **full-text download links** enabling instant one-click access**

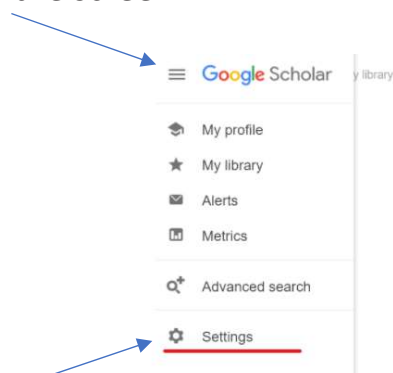

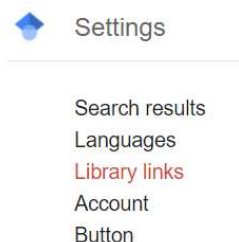
How to access full-text in Google Scholar

To access full-text articles in Google Scholar, please follow the instructions below:

Go to Google Scholar scholar.google.com and click on the three horizontal lines in the top right corner of the screen:



Then select **Settings** and then click on **Library links**



Search for and select up to 5 libraries.

Show library access links for (choose up to five libraries):

e.g., Harvard

To maximise access to full-text available to you, please search for and select the following:

- **Manchester University NHS Foundation Trust**
- **Health Education England**
- **Open WorldCat**

Now when you search Google Scholar, links to full text will appear as follows:
