The new hospital will be one of the most digitally advanced in the country when it opens. It will support smarter ways of working, save time and reduce duplication and delays.

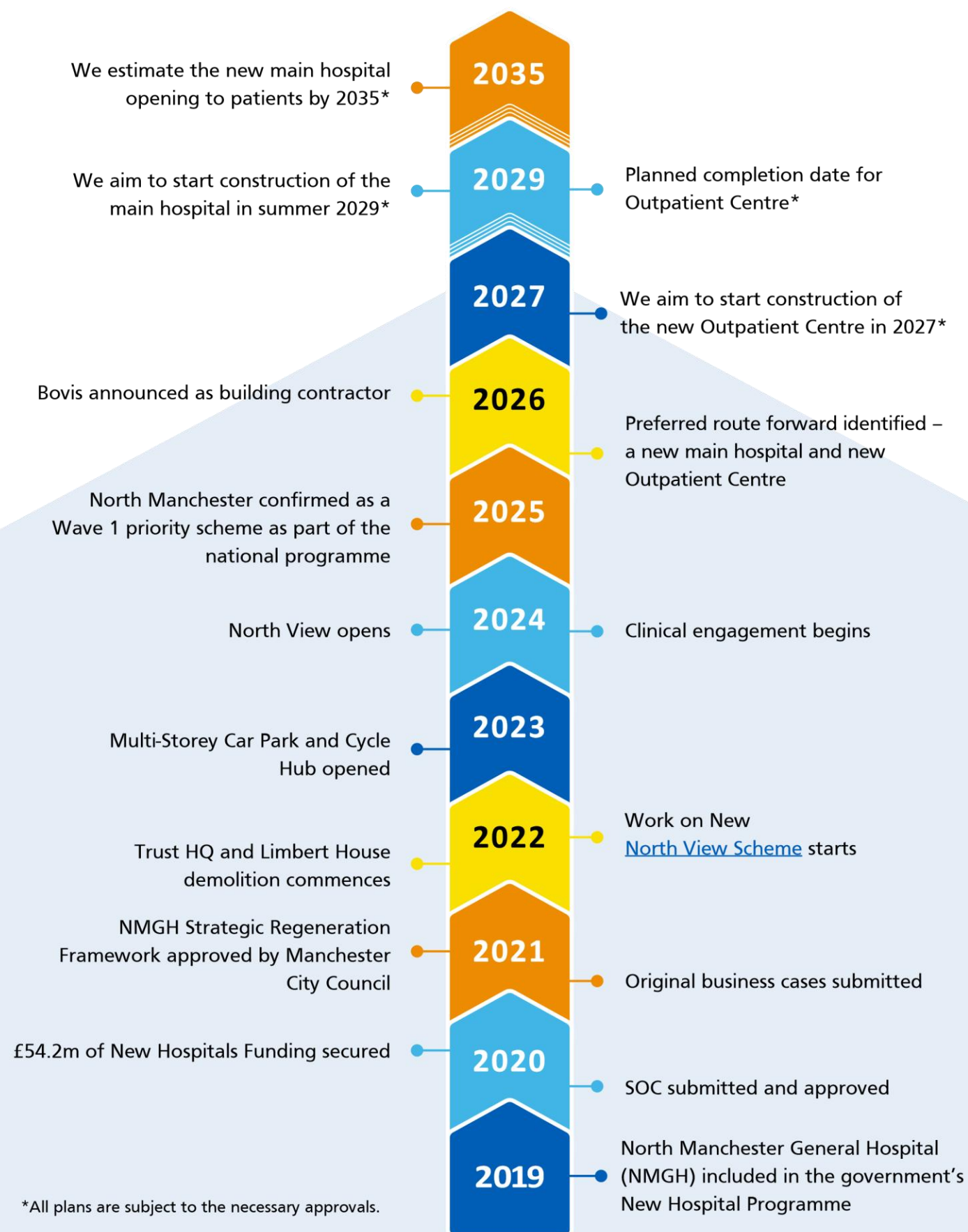


PARTNERSHIPS

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why is the new hospital needed?

North Manchester experiences some of the highest levels of deprivation in England, with significant health inequalities and poorer health outcomes. Alongside creating new hospital buildings, we are transforming the way care is delivered so that patients benefit from the highest standards of acute and specialist care, supported by stronger connections between hospital, community and neighbourhood services. This will help more people receive care closer to home, or in their own homes where appropriate. The redevelopment will also bring wider benefits to the community through jobs, apprenticeships, training and new skills opportunities linked to the construction programme, supporting efforts to reduce health inequalities and improve opportunities for local people. Together, these changes will help transform health and life outcomes across North Manchester while creating an exceptional place to work, learn and innovate.

Will the old hospital remain open during the redevelopment works?

Construction plans will seek to minimise disruption and allow the current hospital and all services to continue to run safely. There will be a carefully planned transfer of clinical services into the new facilities.

How are you involving patients, staff and the community in the design of the hospital?

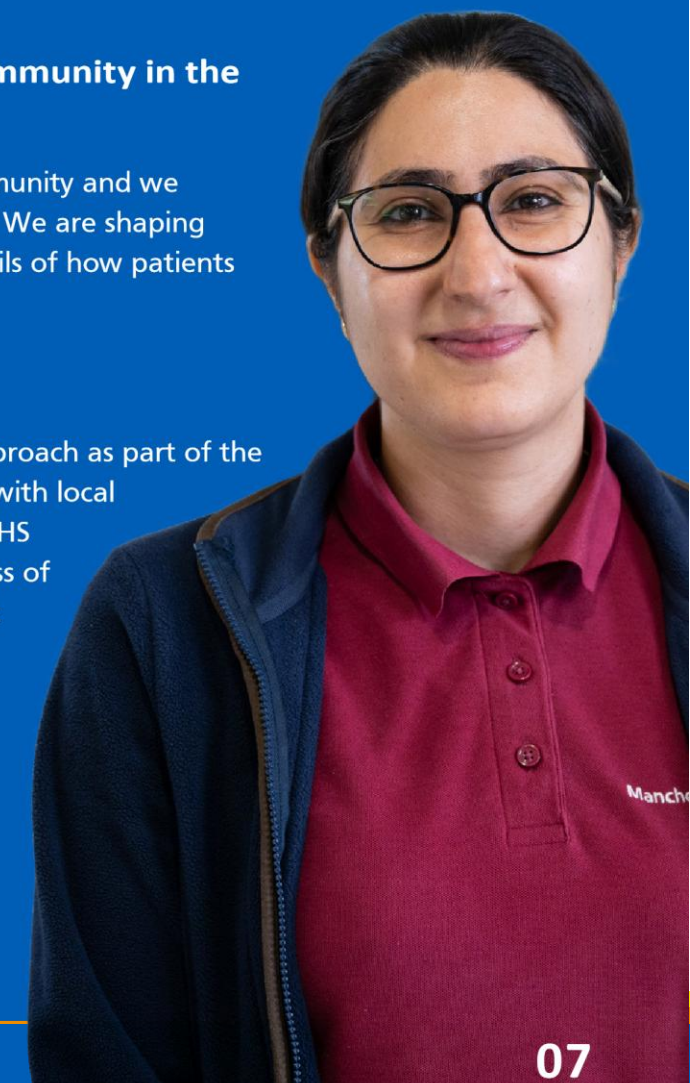

Who are you collaborating with?

A project as big as this needs a collaborative, co-ordinated approach as part of the national New Hospital Programme (NHP). We are partnering with local authorities, Bovis, our construction partner, suppliers, wider NHS partners and community groups. They are all key to the success of the new hospital, and we will be working closely with them at all stages of the development journey.

What is the timeline for the development?

We estimate the new main hospital opening to patients by 2035. We aim to start construction of the new Outpatient Centre in 2027.

Logical design that makes the hospital easier to navigate. Overlap between clinical and public routes will be minimised, supporting a calm and dignified experience for patients and visitors
