Information for Patients

Use and Care of Your Conformer

It is very important to wash your hands thoroughly before inserting or removing the conformer.

Insertion

- 1. Wash hands thoroughly.
- 2. Look downwards.
- 3. Lift the upper eyelid and gently push the conformer upwards under the upper eyelid.
- 4. Look straight ahead and position the lower eyelid over the lower edge of the conformer.

Removal

Use the plastic extractor provided to remove the conformer using the following procedure:

- 1. Wash hands thoroughly.
- 2. Touch the conformer with extractor tip.
- 3. Push lower eyelid down with extractor tip until the tip is beneath the bottom edge of the conformer.
- 4. Look upwards as the handle of the extractor is brought downwards until nearly flat to the cheek.
- 5. Look downwards and the conformer is normally expelled.







Cleaning

The conformer should be removed and cleaned with cooled boiled water twice a day unless otherwise instructed.

It is important to keep the holes in the conformer clear as they allow ventilation, drainage and irrigation, which are very important during the healing process.
