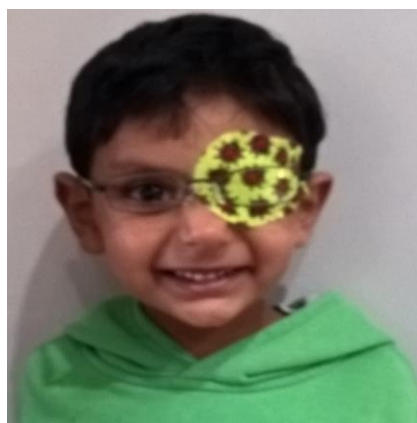
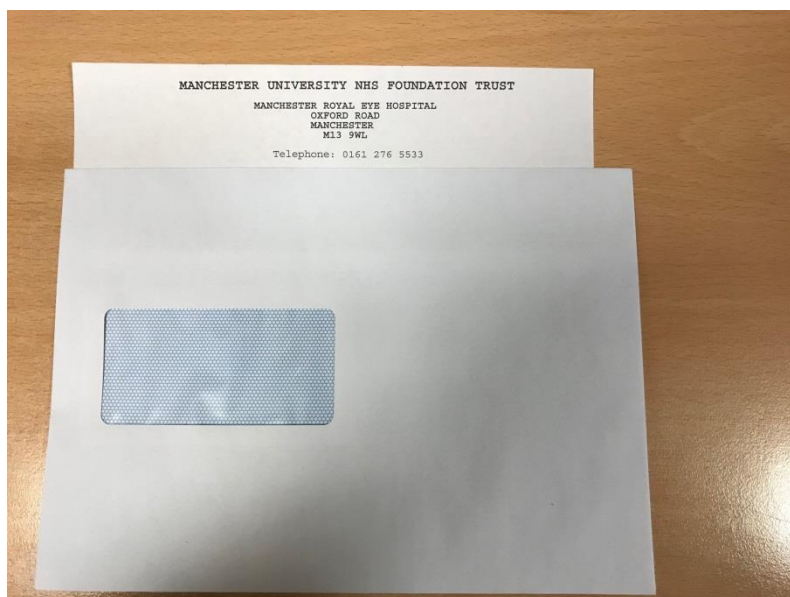

Are there places to buy drinks/snacks?

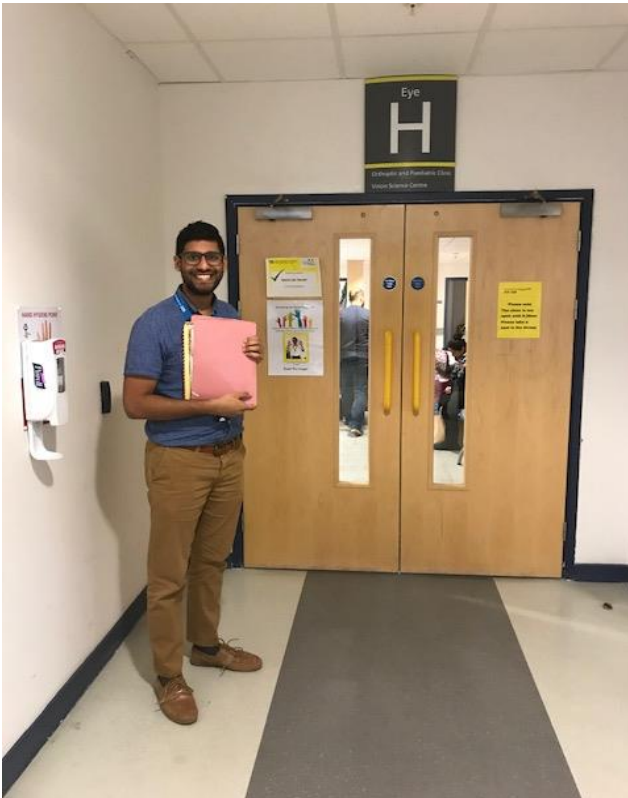
Yes there is a café in the Eye hospital

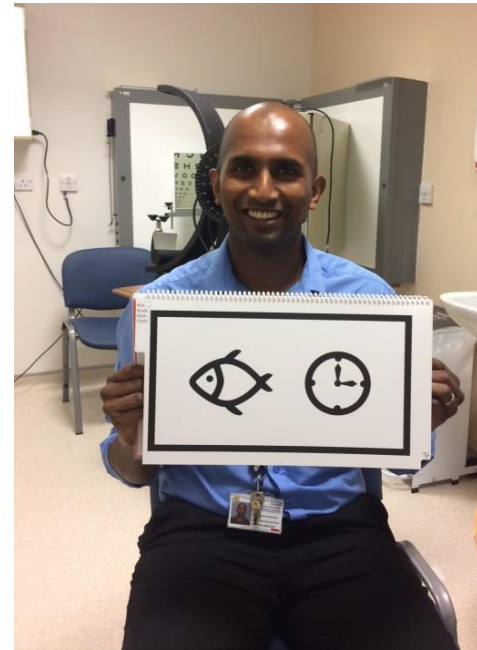

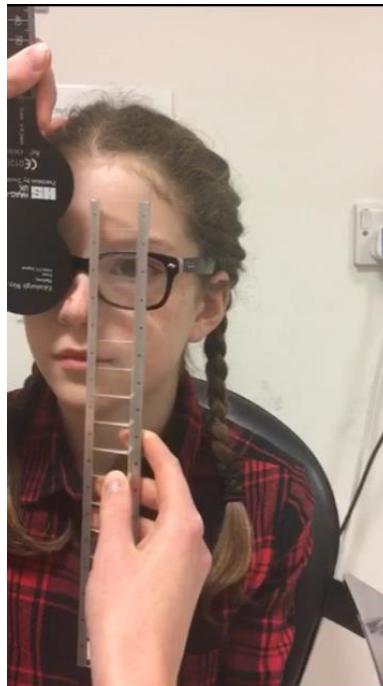


Eye Test

Eye drops

You may need eye drops

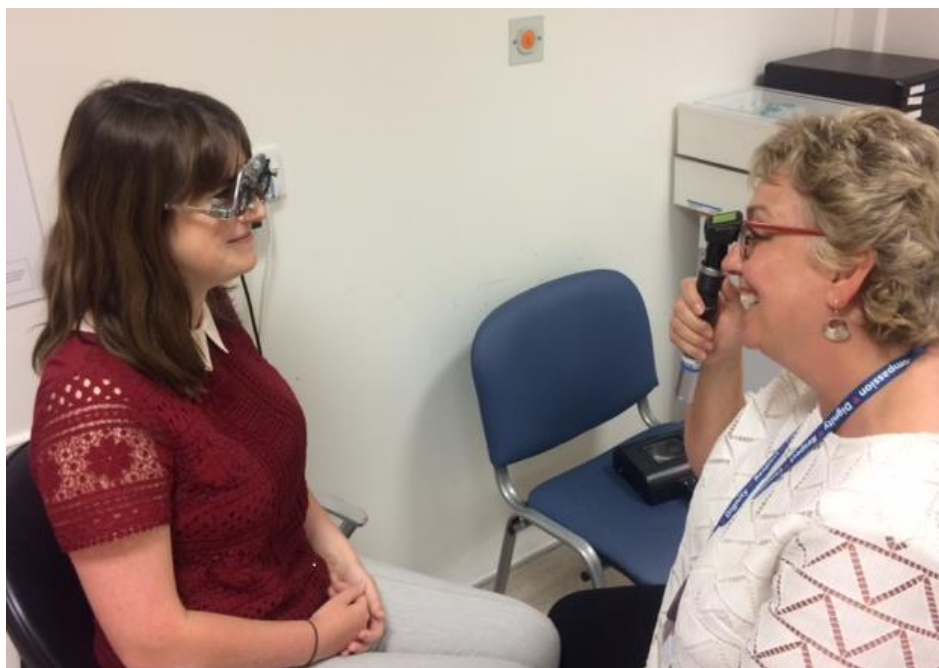
- They feel cold when they go in but if you count to 10 it will feel better
- They make the black part of your eye (pupil) **very** big and your eyesight a bit fuzzy.
- This is so we can look inside your eye
- They will blur your vision for up to four hours



Optometrist



When your pupil is **very** big you may see one of our Optometrists:



They will look in your eyes to see if you need glasses using a bright light

Doctor

The last person to check your eyes will be the doctor



They may look at the back of your eye with a lens.

Check your eye pressure
