
Information for Patients

If you need to visit the Eye Hospital at the moment, we are here to help you and look after you. This booklet explains a bit about how we are doing things a bit differently to help keep you safe.





Before you come, we would like to chat with you and your parents by phone or video chat to introduce ourselves and get to know about you and your eye problem before you come in.



When you arrive you will come straight in to meet your eye specialist. There won't be much hanging around! We want to get you sorted out and on your way home as soon as we can, and we're sure that's what you want too!



Our eye specialists will be wearing special, protective clothes like this. This is to protect you and others from the virus. We know it looks a bit different so please try to remember there are some friendly, helpful people under there.





You and your parents will be asked to wear a mask too. We will ask you to clean your hands with gel when you arrive.

We will help you with your problem and then you can go home again.
