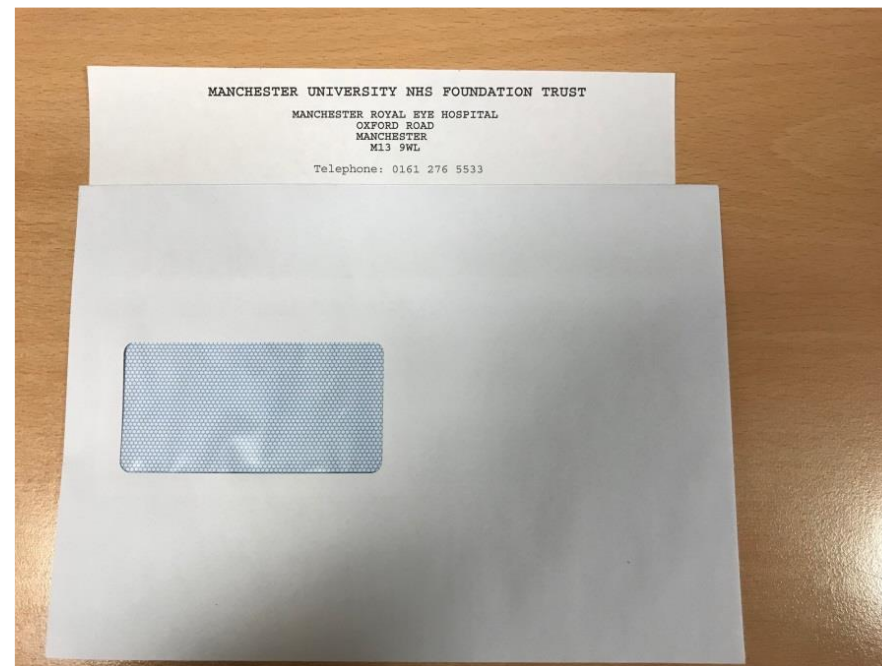

Yes there is a café located in the Eye Hospital



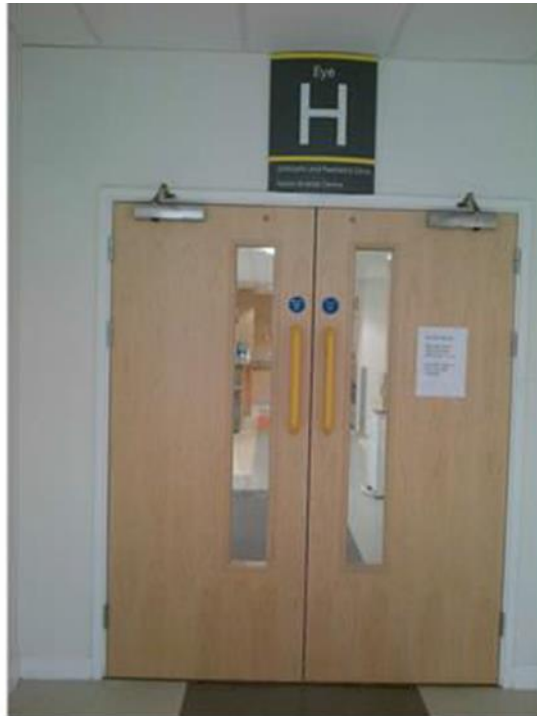
There is also a shop outside the Eye Hospital

- You can use portable games or tablets



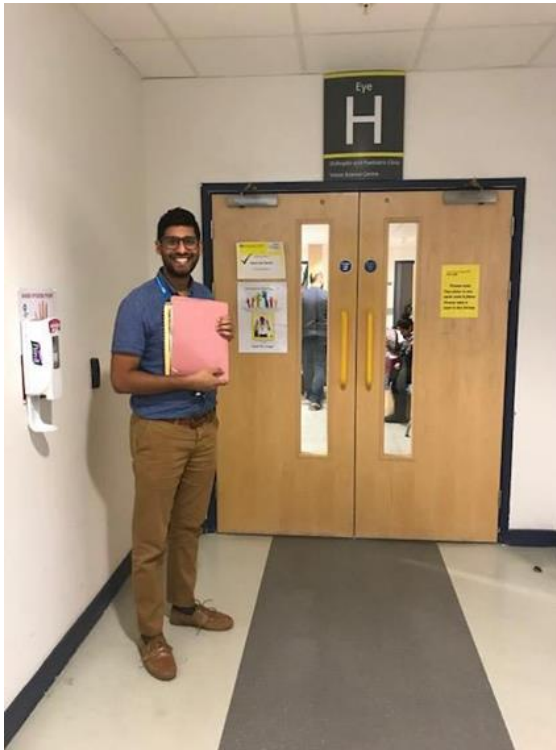
# Waiting Area

You can ask for a pager and can sit elsewhere

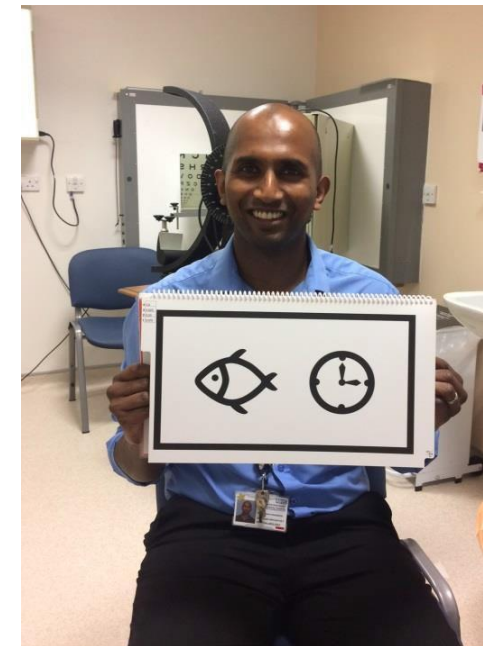
# Orthoptist
