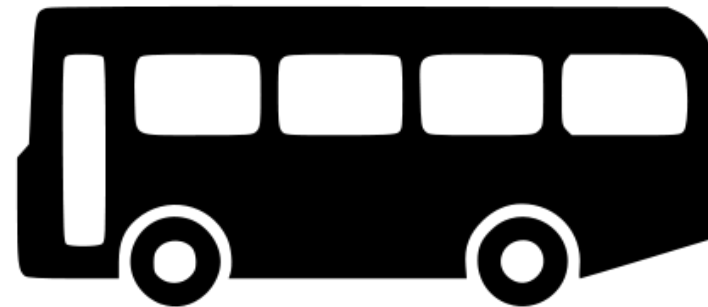

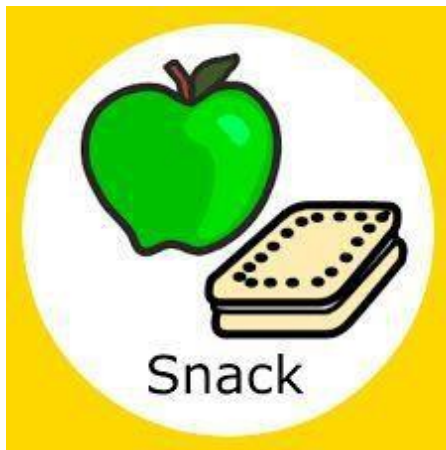

There is also a shop outside the Eye Hospital

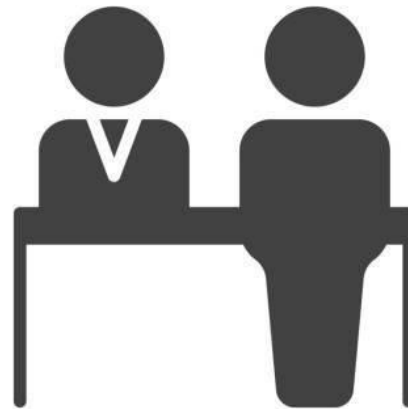

You will sit in our waiting area

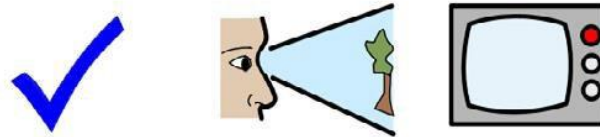


You can listen to the radio

You can use portable games or tablets

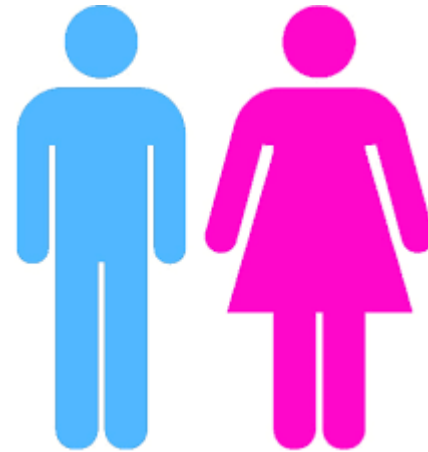

You can ask for a pager and can sit elsewhere

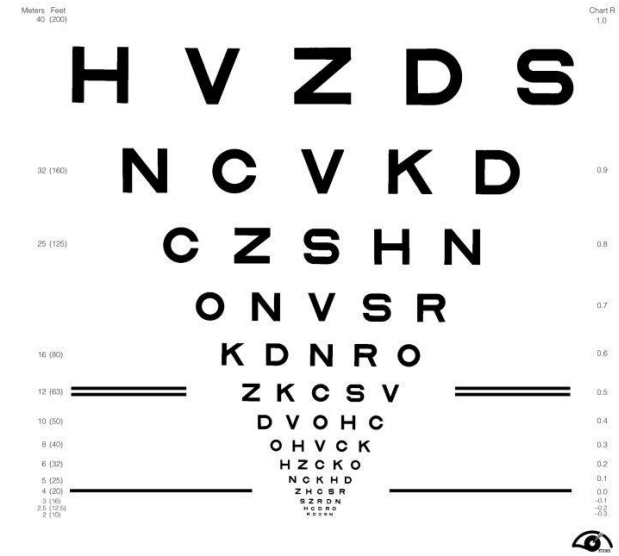
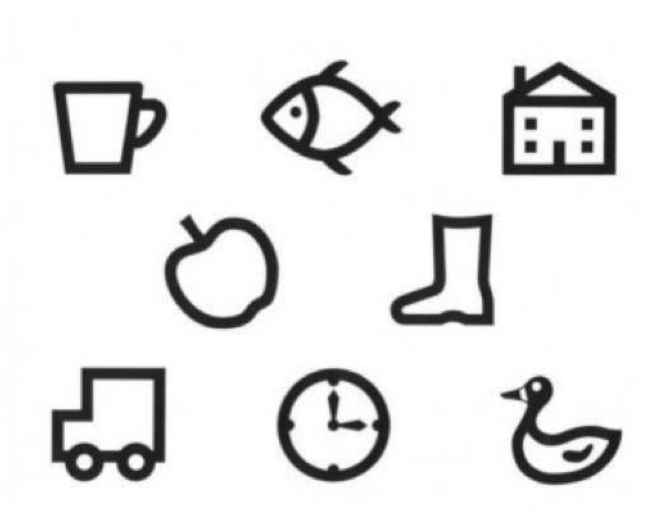

You might see one of our Nurses



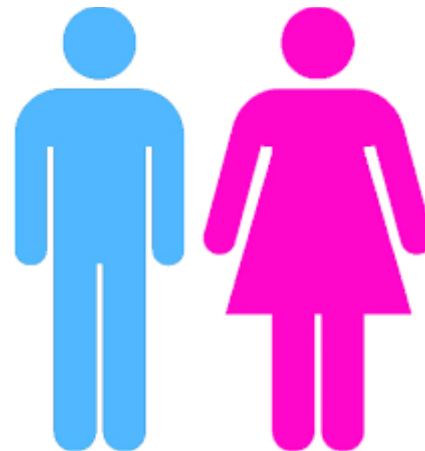
Eye Drops

This is so we can look inside your eye

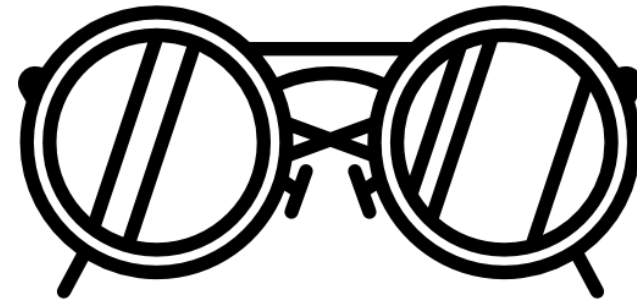
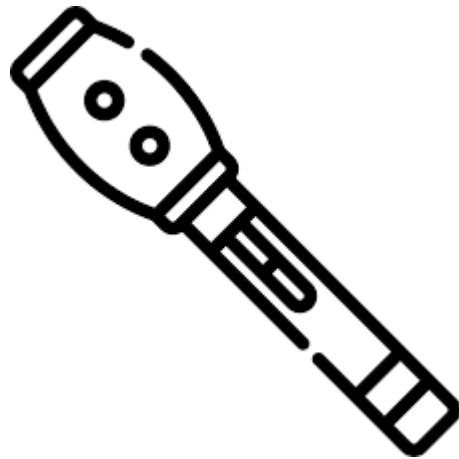
Optometrist
