

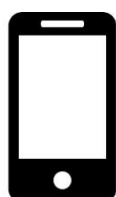

Before you come, we would like to chat with you and your parents by phone or video chat to introduce ourselves and get to know about you and your dental problem before you come in.



When you arrive you will come straight in to meet your dentist and nurse. There won't be much hanging around! We want to get you sorted out and on your way home as soon as we can, and we're sure that's what you want too!



Our dentists and nurses will be wearing special, protective clothes like this. This is to protect you and others from the virus. We know it looks a bit different so please try to remember there are some friendly, helpful people under there.



Your parents will be asked to wear a mask too. Obviously, you can't wear one. That would make looking in your mouth a bit tricky! We will ask you to clean your hands with gel when you arrive.
