



Updated Visiting Policy for Saint Mary's Hospital Managed Clinical Service

From the 30th November 2020

From the Monday 30th November Saint Mary's Hospital will re-introduce partner's attendance at all scans, in line with current NHS midwifery recommendations. This includes ultrasound scans at Saint Mary's Hospital Oxford Road Campus, Wythenshawe, Trafford General Hospital and Lanceburn Health Centre

Current Visiting Guidance in Tier 3

Outpatients: antenatal clinic, ultrasound scans, antenatal assessment unit and triage

- One support person may accompany you when attending for any outpatient appointments. From Monday 30th November 2020 this now includes any ultrasound scan at any gestation.

Induction of labour

- One support person/birth partner may remain with you on the antenatal ward when an admitted for an induction of labour.

Labour and birth

- One support person/birth partner may remain with you during labour and birth.

Antenatal and postnatal wards

- One support person may be with you during visiting hours (8am – 10pm) while you are staying on the ward.

Please note: unfortunately, children are not able to come into the hospital at any time. Support people/birth partners must wear a mask when in the hospital. Support people/birth partners should not change during your admission.
