## UNEXPECTED ANTENATAL ULTRASOUND SCAN RESULT

We are very sorry that you have had an unexpected scan result following your routine antenatal ultrasound scan. We appreciate that this must be a difficult and anxious time for you and others supporting you.

## WHAT HAPPENS NOW

The antenatal team will now refer you to the Emergency Gynaecology Unit and one of the specialist nurses from the team will be in contact with you within the next 1-2 hours by telephone. The specialist nurses will support you through the next steps, discuss ongoing care and arrange further appointments for you, dependent on your individual circumstances.

The Emergency Gynaecology Unit is a 24 hour, 7 days a week service that reviews patients with a range of urgent pregnancy and Gynaecology concerns. Occasionally this could lead to unexpected delays within the department that may impact us contacting you. Although this is rare, if you have not heard from us within 24hours please contact the Emergency Gynaecology Unit on the contact details below.

If you are experiencing any sudden vaginal bleeding/abdominal pain or have any other concerns, please contact the unit on the number below where one of the specialist nurses will be available to support you.
