ENT (Ear, Nose & Throat)



Your child has been referred to the ENT Clinic.

You will be contacted by telephone or letter to arrange further follow-up. This may be either a telephone clinic or face-to-face clinic appointment.

Please make sure that you have given the Paediatric Emergency Department an up-to-date telephone number before you go home, and that you keep your phone switched on so as to not miss their call.

In the meantime, it is important that you follow the advice given to you by the Doctors in the Paediatric Emergency Department.

If you have been told that your child has a broken(fractured) nose, they need to be seen quickly. If you have not heard from the ENT team about your appointment within 3 working days, then please phone or email them to chase this appointment.
