Strategic Aims	To complete the creation of a Single Hospital Service for Manchester (Manchester University NHS Foundation Trust), with minimal disruption whilst ensuring that the planned benefits are realised in a timely manner.
	To improve patient safety, clinical quality and outcomes.
	To improve the experience of patients, carers and their families.
	To develop single services that build on the best from across all our hospitals.
	To develop our research portfolio and deliver cutting edge care to patients.
	To develop our workforce enabling each member of staff to reach their full potential.
	To achieve financial sustainability.

As part of our planning process each year, we also set out key priorities. These are our 'must dos' and they describe what we need to do in the coming 12 months in order to deliver our vision and aims. Our key priorities are set at both Trust and also at individual hospital level.
